 - 1. All can and should be involved in missions in one manner or another.
 - 2. All can and should consider some level of "short term missions."
 - 3. Some are called into "FULL-TIME VOCATIONAL MISSIONS."

A FULL-TIME VOCATIONAL MISSIONARY IS ONE WHO IS CALLED BY GOD TO GO TO A CERTAIN LOCATION (COUNTRY, STATE, CITY) OR A CERTAIN PEOPLE GROUP (A SPECIFIC ETHINIC GROUP OR RELIGION) TO BE PERSONALLY INVOLVED IN EVANGELISM, DISCIPLESHIP (EDIFICATION) AND CHURCH PLANTING (ESTABLISHING CHURCHES).

VII. THE PERSONAL CALL TO MISSIONS

- A. Having an open heart to God's call into missions.
- B. Having a desire for missions involvement.
- C. Having a lasting inward compulsion to GO into missions.
- D. Having an interest in seeing a certain geographical location or people group evangelized.
- E. Having a direction from the Holy Spirit through the Word of God to go into missions ministry.
- F. Having a willing heart to go where the Lord is leading in missions ministry.
