<u>"BELIEVING IS SEEING"</u> 1 THESSALONIANS 2:13

<u>INTRO:</u> In our last study from 1 Thessalonians, we focused on CHAPTER 2 and VERSE 13 that speaks of the effectual working of the WORD OF GOD upon the lives of those who BELIEVE. You may recall that in that study we learned three things:

- 1) THE SCRIPTURE IS THE WORD OF GOD, NOT THE WORD OF MEN
- 2) THE SCRIPTURE IS THE TRUTH OF GOD, AND IS ABSOLUTE TRUTH
- 3) THE SCRIPTURE IS THE OPERATION OF GOD, ACTIVELY ENERGIZING BELIEVERS

Today we are going to return to 1 Thessalonians 2:13 so as to focus on ONE SMALL WORD THAT BRINGS ONE HUGE EFFECT upon those who practice it. It is the very last word of the verse..." <u>BELIEVE."</u> The title of the message today is "BELIEVING IS SEEING." The point of the message is BELIEF IN THE RIGHT THING ALWAYS RESULTS IN SEEING THE DIVINE THING. In other words, WHEN WE TRULY BELIEVE PROPERLY, WE WILL TRULY SEE THE EFFECTUAL WORKING OF GOD IN OUR LIVES.

NOTE: "BELIEVE" in the verse is "PISTEUO" in the Greek which means "TO COMMIT OR TO HAVE FULL CONFIDENCE IN."

<u>A REMINDER:</u> The Bible DOES NOT JUST CONTAIN the Word of God...The Bible IS the Word of God. (Isaiah 55:11; Jeremiah 15:16; John 17:17; 1 Peter 1:23-25)

IF GOD'S WORD IS GOING TO WORK IN OUR LIVES WE MUST BELIEVE!

I. WE MUST BELIEVE IN THE EXISTENCE OF GOD - HEBREWS 11:6

NOTE: THE BELIEF, OR CONFIDENCE IN THE EXISTENCE OF GOD IS THE FOUNDATION OF ALL RIGHT BELIEF!

- A. The Matter of Intellectual Belief The belief that "GOD IS."
 - 1. As Seen in Creation The Universe
 - 2. As Seen in Revelation The Bible
 - 3. As Seen in Illumination The Holy Spirit
 - 4. As Seen in Transformation The Changed Life
- B. The Matter of Emotional Belief The Belief that "GOD IS A REWARDER."

-Recognizing that God has the will, desire, and ability to meet our needs.

- 1. Regarding Salvation
- 2. Regarding all Provision
- C. The Matter of Willful Belief The Belief that we can "WILLINGLY SEEK HIM."
 - 1. Willingly Trusting Christ as Savior through Faith
 - 2. Willingly Trusting God for Provision through Faith

II. WE MUST BELIEVE IN THE EFFICACY OF CHRIST – 1 TIMOTHY 1:15

DEFINITION: "EFFICACY" means "THE POWER TO PRODUCE."

NOTE: THE BELIEF, OR CONFIDENCE THAT THE REDEMPTIVE WORK OF CHRIST IS ALL THE SUFFICIENT POWER NEEDED TO PRODUCE AND PROVIDE ETERNAL SALVATION FOR ALL WHO BELIEVE.

- 1. As Seen in John 14:6
- 2. As Seen in Hebrews 10:11-15

III. WE MUST BELIEVE IN THE EFFECT OF THE SCRIPTURE - 2 TIMOTHY 3:16,17

<u>NOTE:</u> THE BELIEF, OR CONFIDENCE THAT THE SCRIPTURE IS THE FOUNDATION OF TRUE CHRISTIANITY WILL CHANGE THE LIVES OF THOSE WHO OBEY IT.

<u>FACT:</u> THE BIBLE IS, <u>IN TRUTH</u>, THE WORD OF GOD AND IS THE SUPREME AND FINAL AUTHORITY BY WHICH ALL HUMAN CONDUCT, CREEDS AND OPINIONS SHALL BE TRIED.

- A. The Scripture Reveals God to those who Believe it Genesis 1:1
- B. The Scripture Reveals Christ to those who Believe it John 1:1-5,14

- C. The Scripture Saves those who Believe it 1 Peter 1:23
- D. The Scripture Equips those who Believe it 2 Timothy 3:16,17
- E. The Scripture Matures those who Believe it 1 Peter 2:2

APPLICATION AND LESSONS

- 1) Believing the Scripture will lead us to recognize the existence of God and the efficacy of Christ.
- 2) Believing the Scripture will build our faith that will enable us to see the greater working of God in our lives.
