- A. Being Blameless (An outward condition) "To be without a fault before others."
- B. Being Harmless (An inward condition) "To be sincere with a pure heart."
- C. Being Without Rebuke (A general condition) "To be without a moral defect."

THE POINT: Believers are to have a God-Honoring Testimony in the World.

BY REFLECTING A CHRIST-LIKE LIFE-STYLE

NOTE: The Context suggests HUMILITY - Vss. 5-8
