A. The Man of God Flees - "Flee These Things" Vs. 11b

The Man of God FLEES the **LOVE** of and for Material Things

- 1. Material Things Destroy Contentment Vs. 8
- 2. Material Things Bring Temptation Vs. 9a
- 3. Material Things Create Snares Vs. 9b
- 4. Material Things Destroy Godly Living Vs. 9c
- 5. Material Things Remove Genuine Faith Vs. 10a
- 6. Material Things Bring Sorrow Vs. 10b
- B. The Man of God Follows "Follow After" Vs. 11c

The Man of God FOLLOWS Spiritual Virtues

- 1. Righteous and Godliness General Conformity to God's Plan
 - a. Righteousness Being Biblically Correct in all things
 - b. Godliness Maintaining Holy Living in all actions and attitudes
- 2. Faith and Love Foundational Principles for Christian Living
 - a. Faith The Primary Component for Christian living Romans 1:17
 - b. Love The Practical Result of Faith Galatians 5:6
- 3. Patience and Meekness Evident Virtues of Spiritual Maturity
 - a. Patience Godly Endurance in the trials of life
 - b. Meekness Submission to God without rebellion and to mankind without retaliation.
- C. The Man of God Fights "Fight the Good Fight of Faith" Vs. 12a

NOTE: The word "Fight" is a MILITARY AND AN ATHLETIC term to describe the concept of AGONIZING.

NOTE: The "Good Fight of Faith" is the SPIRITUAL CONFLICT we all face with Satan and his minions every day.

The Man of God FIGHTS for Biblical Correctness in Personal and

Societal issues.

- 1. Involves Concentrating on Standing for What is Biblically Correct
- 2. Involves Discipline to Do what is Biblically Correct
- 3. Involves Effort to Win Biblical Correctness
- D. The Man of God Focuses "Lay Hold on Eternal Life" Vs. 12b

The Man of God FOCUSES on that which is of Eternal Value

- 1. Involves "getting a grip" on the reality of Eternal Values
 - a. Salvation
 - b. Sanctification
 - c. Service

- d. Sound Doctrine
- 2. Involves "letting go" of that which has NO Eternal Value

III. THE DECISION OF THE MAN OF GOD

- A. Make Certain **YOU** are a Man of God -Starting with Personal Salvation
- B. Model **YOUR** life according to Biblical Truth
