"CHRISTMAS SERIES: JESUS CHRIST REVEALED IN THE GOSPELS" "JESUS CHRIST REVEALED IN LUKE'S GOSPEL" "THE PERFECT MAN" LUKE 2:41-52

INTRO: When properly understood, the Christmas Season can be the most joyful time of the year. Unfortunately, there are many who DO NOT properly understand what this season is all about. Many see Christmas as simply a secular holiday that is designed for businesses to make a lot of money, for people to attend a lot of parties, for churches to put on a lot of programs, for children to get time off from school for a winter holiday, etc. Consequently, what could be the most joyful time of the year, often becomes the most stressful time of the year. HOW IS IT WITH YOU? To put Christmas into its proper perspective we must CENTER IT AROUND JESUS CHRIST for CHRISTMAS IS THE TIME OF THE YEAR THAT WE CELEBRATE HIS BIRTH. A crucial part of celebrating the birth of Christ is having a proper understanding of who Christ is as REVEALED IN THE SCRIPTURES. THAT IS WHAT OUR CHRISTMAS SERIES OF MESSAGES IS ATTEMPTING TO DO...WHICH IS TO OBSERVE HOW CHRIST IS REVEALED IN THE FOUR GPSOELS. So far, we have noted that:

- In Matthew, Jesus is revealed as THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- In Mark, Jesus is revealed as THE SERVANT OF GOD AND MANKIND.

Today we are going to note that in the GOSPEL OF LUKE Jesus is revealed as **THE PERFECT MAN AND YET 100% GOD**.

SOME SIGNIFICANT OBSERVATIONS ABOUT THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST IN THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

- 1) The Gospel of Luke was written by a PHYSICIAN DR. LUKE. As a PHYSICIAN, Luke understood the REALITY OF HUMANITY, and thus, presented Jesus as the PERFECT MAN, without losing sight of Christ's full Deity. (Luke 22:66-69)
- 2) The Gospel of Luke reveals Jesus as the PERFECT MAN by showing His concern and compassion for the poor, the lame, the lonely, the widows, as a part of His DIVINE MISSION. (Luke 4:18,19)
- 3) The Gospel of Luke records 20 MIRACLES and 23 PARABLES of Christ which reveal and illustrate His concern and sympathy for humanity. (Luke 7:11-15)
- 4) The Gospel of Luke gives MORE TIME to the BIRTH and LIFE of Jesus than any of the other Gospels, thus revealing His HUMANITY in the context of His DEITY.

I. JESUS CHRIST, THE PERFECT MAN WAS REVEALED THROUGH HIS BIRTH

JESUS CHRIST WAS PHYSICALLY AND LITERALLY BORN AS A MAN-CHILD

Luke 1:26-38; 2:7,16

- A. The Miraculous Conception of Christ Maintained His Deity
- B. The Virgin Birth of Christ Guaranteed His Sinlessness
- C. The Physical Birth of Christ Preserved His Humanity

II. JESUS CHRIST, THE PERFECT MAN WAS REVEALED THROUGH HIS GROWTH

JESUS CHRIST PHYSICALLLY GREW AS AHUMAN BEING

Luke 2:41-52

- A. Jesus Christ Grew Like any Normal Child 2:40
- B. Jesus Christ Developed Like any Normal Child 2:52

III. JESUS CHRIST, THE PERFECT MAN WAS REVEALED THROUGH HIS BAPTISM

JESUS CHRIST WAS PHYSICALLY AND LITERALLY BAPTIZED

Luke 3:21,22

NOTE: THE VERY FIRST PUBLIC EVENT OF CHRIST'S EARTHLY MINISTRY WAS HIS BAPTISM!

- A. Christ's Baptism Pictured His Death and Resurrection (Luke 12:50)
- B. Christ's Baptist Prefigured the Significance of Believers Baptism
- C. Christ's Baptism Publicly Identified Him with those whose sins He would Ultimately bear. (1 Peter 3:18)
- D. Christ's Baptism Publicly Affirmed His Messiahship (Vs. 17)

IV. JESUS CHRIST, THE PERECT MAN IS REVEALED THROUGH HIS GENEALOGY

JESUS CHRIST WAS PHYSICALLY AND LITERALLY OF HUMAN LINEAGE

Luke 3:23-38

- A. The Genealogy of Christ in Matthew goes through David to Abraham, and thus establishes Him as the King of the Jews.
- B. The Genealogy of Christ in Luke goes to Adam, and thus establishes Him as a Legitimate Part of the Human Race.

V. JESUS CHRIST, THE PERFECT MAN WAS REVEALED THROUGH HIS TEMPTATION

JESUS CHRIST WAS PHYSICALLY AND LITERALLY TEMPTED BY SATAN

Luke 4:1-13

- A. The Fact that Christ was Tempted Proves His Humanity
- B. The Fact that Christ was Tempted without Sin Proves His Deity

VI. JESUS CHRIST, THE PERFECT MAN WAS REVEALED THROUGH HIS MISSION

JESUS CHRIST PHYSICALLY AND LITERALLY DIED

Luke 19:10

NOTE: The phrase "SON OF MAN" identifies Jesus Christ with Humanity

- A. The Coming of the Son of Man
 - Was Prophesied (Isaiah 7:14) and Performed (Luke 2)
- B. The Compassion of the Son of Man
 - In His Healing and Teaching
- C. The Cross of the Son of Man
 - To Seek and Save that which was Lost
