# "CONSIDER THE HURRICANE" NAHUM 1:1-8

INTRO: One mandate for every child of God is to LOOK AT EVERYTHING THROUGH THE EYES OF THE SCRIPTURE. In other words, we are to yield our thoughts, actions, attitudes, and daily living according to the BIBLICAL WORLD VIEW! Today let's look at a HURRICANE through the eyes of the WORD OF GOD.

#### WHAT IS A HURRICANE?

#### I. FROM THE METEOROLOGICAL PERSPECTIVE

"A HURRICANE IS A TROPICAL STORM WITH WINDS THAT HAVE REACHED A CONSTANT SPEED OF 74 MIES PER HOUR OR MORE. THE EYE OF THE STORM IS USUALLY 20-30 MILES WIDE AND MAY EXTEND OVER 400 MILES. THE DANGERS OF THE STORM INCLUDE TORRENTIAL RAINS, HIGH WINDS AND STORM SURGES."

NOTE: SINCE 2000 AT LEAST 2075 HAVE DIED DUE TO HURRICANES IN AMERICA (This does not include Hurricane Ian). In addition to deaths, BILLIONS OF DOLLARS have been spent due to hurricane damage.

#### II. FROM THE BIBLICAL PERSPECTIVE

"A SPECIFIC ACT OF GOD ESTABLISHED BY THE DIVINE INTENT TO GET THE ATTENTION OF HUMANITY, TO BRING JUDGMENT UPON WICKEDNESS, TO BRING REPENTENCE TO MANKIND AND TO ILLUSTRATE HIS GREAT POWER."

## THE BIBLICAL/HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF NINEVEH

- 1) Jonah preached to Nineveh over 100 years prior to the time of Nahum, (862 BC). At that point in time, Nineveh repented but then they turned away into apostasy and was about ready to be judged by God again.
- 2) Nahum pronounced God's Judgment upon Nineveh by way of an "OVERUNNING FLOOD" (Vs. 8) that took place in 612 BC when the TIGRIS RIVER flooded and destroyed enough of the City Walls to allow the Babylonians to swarm in and destroy it. Nahum 3:11 predicted that the city would be "HID" after its judgment and indeed was hidden for 2,454 years until it was discovered in 1842 AD.

THE LESSON: GOD GIVES ROOM FOR REPENTANCE, BUT EVENTUALLY HE WILL JUDGE SIN!

# NAHUM'S DESCRIPTION OF GOD'S JUDGMENT - VSS. 2-6

THIS IS SOMETHING MANY PEOPLE AVOID TO UNDERSTAND TODAY, BUT IS SOMETHING THAT <u>MUST</u>
BE CONSIDERED!

- 1) He is a Jealous God Vs. 2a (God wants our FULL ATTENTION)
- 2) He is a Revengeful God Vs. 2b (God will PUNISH SIN)
- 3) He is a Furious God Vs. 2c (God has GREAT DISPLEASURE over Sin)
- 4) He is a Wrathful God Vs. 2d (God's OUTBURST OF RAGE against Sin)

- 5) He is Slow to Anger Vs. 3a (God's HEAVY BREATHING against Sin)
- 6) He is Great in Power Vs. 3b (God is ALL-POWERFUL)
- 7) He Judges the Wicked Vs. 3c (God WILL NOT EXCUSE WICKEDNESS)
- 8) He Judges through "Natural" Events Vss. 3b-5 (God Judges NATURALLY)
- 9) He is "ALL-INCLUSIVE" in His Judgment Vs. 6 (God JUDGES ALL)

## NAHUM'S DESCRIPTION OF GOD'S GRACE - VS. 7

IN THE MIDST OF GOD'S JUDGMENT HIS GRACE IS POURED OUT UPON THE REMNANT OF THE FAITHFUL!

- 1) God is Good Vs. 7a (God is FULL OF GOODNESS)
- 2) God is a Stronghold Vs. 7b (God is our FORTIFIED DEFENSE)
- 3) God is Knowledgeable of those who Trust Him Vs. 7c (God RECOGNIZES those who trust Him)
