### <u>"EXAMINE YOURSELF TODAY"</u> <u>1 CORINTHIANS 13:5</u>

INTRO: There are many people in church today all around the world who "THINK" they are saved for one reason or another, but are fooled by their own thinking and Satan's deception. So to help you to focus on the reality of YOUR SALVATION I ask you these two questions:

1) HAVE YOU COME TO THE PLACE IN YOUR SPIRITUAL LIFE WHERE YOU KNOW FOR CERTAIN THAT IF YOU WERE TO DIE TODAY YOU WOULD GO TO HEAVEN?

2) SUPPOSE THAT YOU WERE TO DIE TODAY AND STAND BEFORE GOD AND HE WOULD SAY TO YOU, "WHY SHOULD I LET YOU INTO MY HEAVEN," WHAT WOULD YOU SAY?

THESE TWO QUESTIONS lay the foundation of a PERSONAL EXAMINATION I encourage you to take this morning. 2 Corinthians 13:5 presents the challenge for the exam which will serve as the basis of our study today.

NOTE: One significant consideration about 2 Corinthians 13:5 is that it is WRITTEN TO A LOCAL CHURCH AT CORINTH that faced a lot of spiritual issues and Paul was concerned about the salvation of the members there. THIS IS AN APPLICABLE TO EVERY CHURCH AND EVERY CHRISTIAN TODAY.

1) "Examine" - To Put To The Test to make sure of Your Salvation.

- 2) "Faith" To have Genuine Faith In Christ for Personal Salvation
- 3) "Prove" To be Found Approved of God After the Test of Salvation
- 4) "Know" To be Fully Persuaded without Any Doubt of Your Salvation
- 5) "Reprobates" To be Rejected by God due to the lack of Salvation
