"THE GOD OF THE IMPOSSIBLE"
LUKE 1:34-37

INTRO: Review from previous weeks. Coming into the passage before us, Gabriel had just told Mary two things that would be impossible from the human point of view:

- That she was going to have a baby apart from human conception – Vs. 35
- That her cousin Elisabeth was going to have a baby in old age – Vs. 36

Obviously, this must have brought a high level of amazement upon Mary and Gabriel knew it for he said: **"FOR WITH GOD, NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE."** It is apparent that Mary believed Gabriel's words. **DO WE?**

NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE WITH GOD...NOTHING!
