<u>"THE UNFOLDING ACCOUNT OF THE BIRTH OF JESUS CHRIST"</u> <u>MATTHEW 1:16-25</u>

<u>INTRO:</u> Matthew 1:16-25 is a passage of scripture we are all familiar with as it relates to the birth of the Lord Jesus Christ. However, many times we read it without giving too much thought to the DIVINE SIGNIFICANCE AND PURPOSE OF THE TEXT. The first part of verse 18 actually presents the purpose for the entire text when it says: "NOW THE BIRTH OF JESUS CHRIST WAS ON THIS WISE." In that phrase the Holy Spirit is giving us a heads up on what He wants us to know about our Savior's birth. Please note some observations about verse 18:

1) <u>The word "NOW"</u> indicates a change of order in the text. In verses 1-17 the scripture presents the HUMAN GENEOLOGY OF CHRIST through JOSEPH, though we keep in mind that he was NOT the human father of our Lord. But the purpose of this genealogy is to show the ROYAL LINEAGE OF JESUS CHRIST.

2) <u>The word "BIRTH"</u> indicates that Jesus was actually physically born into the human race.

3) The words "JESUS CHRIST" indicate WHO Jesus truly is:

- JESUS = His Human Name which means "SALVATION IS OF THE LORD."
- CHRIST = His Divine Title which means "THE ANOINTED MESSIAH."

SIGNIFICANT OBSERVATIONS OF VERSES 16-18

1) <u>Verse 16</u> - There is a clear change in the terminology at this point. Up to this point the word "BEGAT" is used (at least 37 times) to indicate the physical birth of those named in the genealogy. Verse 16 does NOT say that Joseph "BEGAT" Jesus, but that <u>"JOSEPH WAS THE HUSBAND OF MARY OF WHOM WAS</u> BORN JESUS" indicating that Joseph was NOT the actual human father of Jesus.

2) <u>Verse 17</u> - Indicates 3 separate times in Israel's history: (Over 2000 years)

- From Abraham to David The Patriarchal period of Israel.
- From David to Babylon The Monarchal period of Israel.
- From Babylon to Christ The Dark-Aged period of Israel.

<u>NOTE:</u> The Birth of Jesus Christ brought a drastic change to Israel. From the history of the PATRIARCHAL FATHERS to the HUMAN KINGS of Israel, to the DISPERSION IN CAPTIVITY of Israel to the ARRIVAL OF THE PROMISED MESSIAH.

3) <u>Verse 18</u> - Reveals a change for Israel from their DARK AGES to their opportunity to experience the SPIRITUAL LIGHT AND HOPE OFFERED THROUGH JESUS CHRIST THE MESSIAH. Compare John 1:1-13.

A VERSE-BY-VERSE PRESENTATION OF THE VIRGIN BIRTH OF CHRIST VERSES 18-25

- 6) <u>Verses 24,25</u>: The Obedience of Joseph "Did as the Angel of the Lord"

- A. God's Plan Promised Redemption to all of Humanity Genesis 3:15
- B. God's Plan Preserved the Seed through Abraham Genesis 12:1-3
- C. God's Plan Prophesied the Birth of the Messiah Isaiah 7:14
- D. God's Plan Prepared the Personnel to Use Matthew 1:16

II. THE INCARNATION REVEALS THAT GOD HAD A PURPOSE TO PROMOTE

A. To Provide a Savior – Vs. 21

"HE SHALL SAVE HIS PEOPLE FROM THEIR SINS"

- 1. The People Identified Romans 1:16
- 2. The Process Included:
- a. The Virgin Birth of Christ To Maintain Christ's Sinlessness
- b. The Sacrificial Death of Christ To Pay the Wage of Sin
- c. The Victorious Resurrection of Christ To Provide Eternal Life
- d. The Glorious Ascension of Christ To Secure Intercession for Us
- B. To Provide a Revelation Vs. 23

"GOD WITH US"

- 1. The Revelation of God through Jesus was necessary for Humanity to understand the Holy Nature of God via Christ's Presence John 1:14-18.
- 2. The Revelation of God through Jesus was necessary for Redemption to be provided 2 Corinthians 5:21.
