"UNDERSTANDING THE CHRISTIAN LIFE IN RELATION TO THE HOLY SPIRIT" JOHN 16:7-17

<u>INTRO:</u> In understanding the CHRISTIAN LIFE, it is important to recognize that a person MUST BE RIGHTLY RELATED TO JESUS CHRIST. 1 Corinthians 6:11 says that believers are "WASHED, SANCTIFIED AND JUSTIFIED IN THE NAME OF THE LORD JESUS." CHRISTIANITY BEGINS WITH A RIGHT RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST:

- Recognize that you are a born sinner Romans 3:23
- Recognize that as a sinner you are separated from God Romans 6:23a
- Recognize that you NEED God's gift of Salvation Romans 6:23b
- Recognize that JESUS is the ONLY SAVIOR Acts 4:12
- Recognize that you MUST TRUST Christ alone as Savior Galatians 3:24

But 1 Corinthians 6:11 goes on to say, "BY THE SPIRIT OF OUR GOD." Without the ministry of the Holy Spirit, we could NOT HAVE A RIGHT RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS CHRIST. Therefore, if we are going to have a PROPER UNDERSTANDING OF THE CHRISTIAN LIFE, it is significant for us to have an UNDERSTANDING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

SOME OBSERVATIONS ON UNDERSTANDING THE HOLY SPIRIT

NOTE: The Official Theological name for the study of the Holy Spirit is

PNEUMATOLOGY

<u>DR. LEWIS SPERRY CHAFER SAID:</u> "IT IS RECOGNIZED THAT THE HOLY SPIRIT, BEING THE ACTIVE DIVINE AGENCY IN THE WORLD, EXERCISES A CONSTANT SOVEREIGNTY OVER THE AFFAIRS OF MEN OF ALL CLASSES AND OF ALL DISPENSATIONS. THE STUPENDOUS PROGRAM OF GOD IS ALL THE SOVEREIGN WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT."

- 1) There Is a General lack of understanding of the Holy Spirit by many Christians.
- 2) There is a lot of Confusion about the Holy Spirit by many Christians.
- 3) There is no Salvation without the ministry of the Holy Spirit.
- 4) There is no Bible without the Holy Spirit.
- 5) There is no Biblical learning without the Holy Spirit.
- 6) There is no Power to live victoriously without the Holy Spirit.
- 7) There is no Assurance of our salvation without the Holy Spirit.
- 8) There is no Effective prayer without the Holy Spirit.

A BIBLICAL SURVEY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

NOTE: The Holy Spirit is NOT just a force, He is the THIRD PERSON of the DIETY Who shares ALL of the ATTRIBUTES OF GOD.

I. THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

NOTE: The Holy Spirit is SO IMPORTANT TO GOD that He is introduced in the second verse of the Bible – Genesis 1:2

- A. The Holy Spirit was Involved in Creation Genesis 1:2; Job 26:13
- B. The Holy Spirit was Involved in Conviction Genesis 6:3
- C. The Holy Spirit was Involved in Causes Psalm 51:11

II. THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE GOSPELS

NOTE: The Gospels provide a PERIOD OF INSTRUCTION AND TRANSITION of the Ministry of the Holy Spirit through the clear teaching of Jesus Christ.

A. The Unique Ministry of the Holy Spirit was Prophesied by Christ -John 7:37-39

<u>NOTE:</u> Here the Lord Jesus was speaking of the FUTURE MINISTRY of the Holy Spirit's ministry of providing SPIRITUAL SATISFACTION to believers in the coming church age.

B. The Unique Ministry of the Holy Spirit was Promised by Christ

(CHRIST GAVE THIS TEACHING RIGHT BEFORE HIS CRUCIFIXION)

- 1. In Relationship to the Believers John 14:16-18,26; 15:26
 - a. He will Comfort Believers John 14:16a
 - b. He will Abide with Believers Forever John 14:26b
 - c. He will Indwell Believers John 14:17
 - d. He will Teach Believers John 14:26
 - e. He will Testify of Christ to the Believers John 15:26
- 2. In Relationship to the Unbelievers (The World) John 16:7-11

NOTE: The word "REPROVE" means "CONVICT" or "EXPOSE."

- a. He will Convict the World of Sin Vs. 8a,9
 - -Reveal to Unbelievers that they are Sinners
- b. He will Convict the World of Righteousness Vs. 8b,10
 - -Reveal to Unbelievers that reality of Righteousness in Christ
- c. He will Convict the Wold of Judgment Vs. 8c,11
 - -Reveal to Unbelievers that the World is Judged with Satan

III. THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE BOOK OF ACTS

<u>NOTE:</u> In the Book of the Acts the Holy Spirit BEGINS to do what Christ predicted He would do in the Gospels in relation to the Church Age in which we live.

- A. The Holy Spirt began to Empower Believers Acts 1:8; 2:1-4
- B. The Holy Spirit began to Build the Church Acts 2:41,47; 1 Corinthians 12:13

IV. THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE LIFE OF THE BELIEVER

<u>NOTE</u>: In the Church Age the Holy Spirit has a relationship with Believers in a unique way in comparison to any other dispensation... which must be understood if we are going to understand the Christian Life.

- A. The Holy Spirit Regenerates Believers Titus 3:5
- B. The Holy Spirit Baptizes Believers 1 Corinthians 12:13
- C. The Holy Spirit Indwells Believers 1 Corinthians 6:19,20
- D. The Holy Spirit Seals Believers Ephesians 4:30
- E. The Holy Spirit Fills Believers Ephesians 5:18
- F. The Holy Spirit Teaches Believers 1 John 2:20,27
- G. The Holy Spirit Strengthens Believers Galatians 5:16
- H. The Holy Spirit Leads Believers Romans 8:14
- I. The Holy Spirit Assures Believers Romans 8:15-17

LESSON/APPLICATION

As believers we must properly respond to the Holy Spirit by not grieving or quenching Him, but by yielding to Him in our EVERYDAY LIFE.
