"<u>UNITY: A MANDATE FROM GOD"</u> <u>EPHESIANS 4:1-6</u>

<u>INTRO:</u> One of the things that brings instability and the lack of peace to a person, a church, a community or a nation is DISUNITY! In addition, one of the things Satan uses to disrupt lives of people on every level and in every institution is DISUNITY! We have just gone through a major national Presidential election and in some sense there appears to be DISUNITY that if not resolved will weaken America within and in our relationship with other nations of the world. UNITY IS A MANDATE FROM GOD! IT IS NOT AN OPTION BUT IT IS WHAT HE EXPECTS, PARTICULARLY FROM HIS PEOPLE. So let's consider the concept of Biblical Unity and what it takes to achieve it in every level of life.

DEFINITION OF BIBLICAL UNITY:

- 1) The Hebrew word "YACHAD" "Alike" "All At Once"
- 2) The Greek word "HENOTES" "The state of being one in agreement and uniform."
- 3) John Piper: "Unity includes affectionate love, not just sacrifice for those you don't like.
- 4) The Definition: "The state of being in ONE MIND with others for the sake of accomplishing the will of God in the home, the church and the community."

- E. The Principle of Endurance A constant effort to maintain unity

APPLICATION/LESSON:

- 1) Satan will always attempt to disrupt and bring disunity.
- 2) The Holy Spirit always builds unity.
- 3) The Christian is to endeavor to create unity in every part of his life...home, church, community...which will bring the blessing of the Lord
- "BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKERS: FOR THEY SHALL BE CALLED THE CHILDREN OF GOD." Matthew 5:9
- 4) The Christian who creates DISUNITY is in a bad way with God
- "THESE SIX THINGS DOTH THE LORD HATE: YEA, EVEN SEVEN ARE AN ABOMINATION TO HIM: A PROUD LOOK, A LYING TONGUE, AND HANDS THAT SHED INNOCENT BLOOD, AN HEART THAT DEVISETH WICKED IMAGINATIONS, FEET THAT BE SWIFT IN RUNNING TO MISCHIEF, A FALSE WITNESS THAT SPEAKETH LIES, AND HE THAT SOWETH DISCORD AMONG BROTHERN."
