-Psalm 115:3; Isaiah 43:13

II. WHAT DOES GOD BEING THE GOD OF THE IMPOSSIBLE MEAN TO US?

- D. We Should Take All of our Burdens to Him.
- E. We Should Not Hesitate to Step out in Faith.

- B. Observe What God has done in YOUR Life
 - 1. Record the Works of God in your life
 - 2. Recall the Works of God in your life
